Roger Jones and Clayton Hale will coordinate life jackets. 242 life jackets are available in total and will be delivered for the boat show use. Loaner stations: should only have new life jackets or life jackets in excellent condition due to liability. Pegy will check with National on a liability/disclaimer statement to be used at loaner stations (since we are not fitting children and adults with correct sizes, what is clubs liability?). • Grand Lake Boat Show: March 17, 18 & 19, 2023 in Vinita. Set up March 16. Need 3 trucks or truck with trailer to deliver life jackets. Roger Jones will coordinate Boat Show. Friday; March 17 staff booth. 10:00 am until 8:00 pm. Saturday, March 18 distribution of life jackets from 10:00 am until 8:00 pm or until supply is depleted. Sunday, March 19, staff booth 10:00 am until 3:00 pm. Break down booth at 3:00 pm. Clayton Hale will help to close booth and coordinate delivery of booth items back to storage or GLVS. Need sign up sheets at the dinner meeting for Boat Show volunteers. Pegy has the sign up sheets.
